

July 13, 2021 Com. Day/Events Meeting

The June 13, 2021 Community Day/Events meeting was called to order by Chairman Daubenspeck at 7:05 p.m. in the Recreation Building, located on Main Road.

Mr. Lucas informed members he would speak with the antique tractor guys to see if they would be willing to pull the hay wagon during part of the day

Chairman Daubenspeck discussed allowing businesses to sell products, excluding food, at Community Day. There would be no fee for Franklin Township businesses or businesses owned by people living in Franklin Township. He also noted that there would be no set up on Friday night, due to the fact people can set up from 8:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. He further reported: (1) The cost of fireworks increased from \$4,500.00 to \$5,000.00. (2) The air show increased from \$6,500.00 to \$7,000.00. Details for the show contract is being handled by the Township Administrator (3) No luck getting a Monster Truck to date. (4) The Ax Throwing vendor wants a fee of \$900.00. We would sell tickets and anything over \$900.00 would be ours. The typical cost is \$1.00 per throw. (5) He will stop by the Paint Ball business to invite them to participate in the event. (6) Will try to Roller Hockey to team up with Little League on splitting the day selling cheese steaks. (7) Questioned the best time for the K-9 dog demonstration.

Mrs. Neely replied the best time would be around 6:00 p.m. when it is cooler and less sun. She reported that she secured the County Road sign for the event. She stated she would check with the DECA club when school reopens regarding volunteers.

Mr. Marsh noted that the hole near the road needed to have a barricade around it and added that they have to pull a car out every year. He also stated that the Portable Toilets need to be maintained and that they were in terrible condition later in the dat.

It will be brought to the attention of the vendor. It was noted it would be a shorter day this year.

Mrs. Coulbourn questioned if the Recreation Tents would be set up Friday.

Chairman Daubenspeck replied yes and that Bernie Simkins son-in-law would be setting up the tents and taking them down. In return, he will be allowed to borrow them if needed. He added that we will need additional tables and chairs.

Mrs. Coulbourn questioned if the bleachers have been reserved.

Chairman Daubenspeck stated he would take care of the bleachers in September. He also stated that he would check with Soyan Unkow regarding the Art Students doing face painting. He reported he would contact Al Batten regarding sending a copy of the grounds lay out for Community Day to Bernie.

Mr. Daubenspeck also stated he would contact Delsea Regarding having someone take film and photos of the event.

The meeting adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
