- We have a limited number of tests available and will select among registrants by first prioritizing previous water testing history and then by earliest registration.

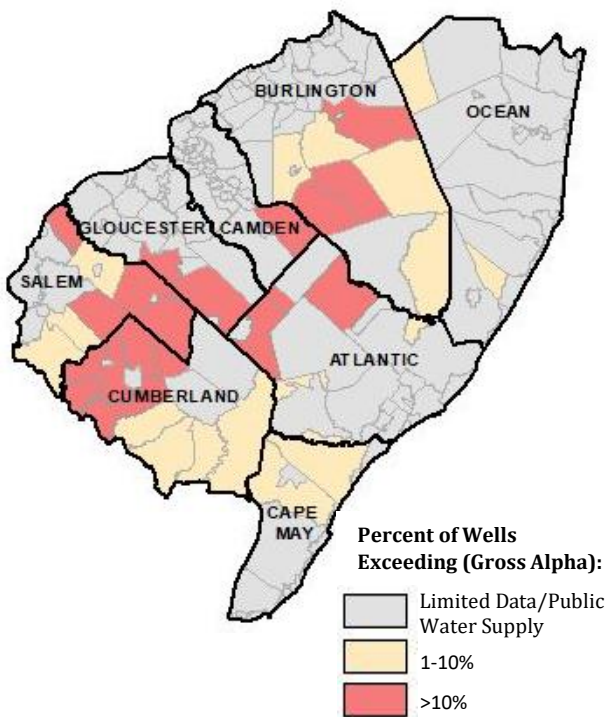
